English

Fiction: Weslandia

Historical: The Story of Tutankhamun.

The children will begin by exploring the history of Tutankhamun and writing reports about Ancient Egypt before going on to find out about Howard Carter and exploring the stories and legends about the curse of Tutankhamun's tomb.
