Fantasy Worlds - *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe* by

C.S. Lewis:

The children begin by exploring the idea that a character can change over time, by using predictions, we will see what the class expect to happen at different junctures of the story. This will improve their powers of inference and interpretation.

Poetry - *The Jabberwocky* by Lewis Carroll:

The children will look at entymology and morphology before creating their own nonsense poem based on the famous creature created by Lewis Carroll.

Computing - Repetition in Programming

The children will use Scratch to devise a computer game and develop their programming skills with the use of animation and repetition.

P.E.

Children continue to develop athletic and gymnastic skills, we will be learning to chase, throw and catch a rolling ball.

D&T - Edible Garden

We will learn how to grow, and prepare for eating herbs and vegetables. Includes tasting sessions!

Science - Animals, including humans

We will be exploring the teeth and digestive processes of all animals, and including humans in this. We will be designing an experiment on tooth decay, and seeing the effects of different drinks on our teeth!

Curriculum Web Year Four Half Term 6

Humanities-History

Continuing our theme from last term we will be looking at how Islam spread, and it's influence as it entered Europe through Spain. We will look at the architecture and history of Cordoba.

Geography

Children will study the desert environment, looking specifically at the Sahara and Patagonian deserts. What wildlife lives there? Is a desert always hot?

French

Class Four will be learning the names of different foods, and how to order and pay for them in a café!
