English

The children will study:

*Tar Beach by Faith Ringgold, in which the children explore the theme of 'freedom'.

Curriculum Web Year Four Half Term 1

Science - States of Matter

This unit teaches about the differences between solids, liquids and gases, classifying objects and identifying their properties. The children will work scientifically and collaboratively to investigate the weight of a gas. Furthermore, they will have chance to find the ideal temperature to melt chocolate. They will explore in-depth how water changes state, exploring melting, freezing, condensing as well as a particular focus on evaporation.

Humanities

History

In this unit, children head back in time to find out how the Roman Empire began and how it expanded to conquer the continent of Europe and beyond.

Geography

The class will be looking at the continent of Europe from the river Rhine to the Mediterranean Sea. We will look at the different climates and physical and human geography of the area.

Religious Education - Jesus the Son of God

This unit will deepen the children's understanding of Jesus, who he was, his teaching and behaviour.

P.E.

Children develop athletic and gymnastic skills, we will be looking at static balance on one leg, and travelling with fluency and control.

Computing - Scratch

In this unit the children write quizzes by combining questions. While specific skills in Scratch are taught, the unit aims to teach children the wider programming skills of solving problems, testing, debugging, improving and evaluating.

Art

The children will be learning different painting techniques. They will apply colour in a variety of ways to different surface textures.

Music - Violin

The children will begin to learn how to play the violin during this half term. We will learn how to hold the violin correctly, and how to play notes with the bow.

French

Children continue to develop French using descriptive words for themselves, their families and friends.
