English

*Odd and the Frost Giant by Neil Gaiman & Chris Riddell

They will explore a range of grammatical concepts and take part in drama activities. They will write an explanation as well as a narrative.

*The Matchbox Diary by Paul Fleischman

The children will discover a set of matchboxes containing some of the mementoes from the story. After writing predictions about what the objects might relate to, the children will listen to the story in stages.

P.E. - Real PE/Swimming

Children develop their skills of sending and receiving a ball, and counter balancing with a partner. They will also continue their swimming program

Geography - Tourism

The children will study tourism and how it has changed to encompass holidays both in the UK and abroad. Types of vacations families choose to go on and how people in tourist areas have embraced the visitors to their area.

D&T-Design a Light

We will be designing and making a child friendly torch.

Science - Data Collection and Sustainability

We will be looking at examples of local wildlife and how we can use energy more efficiently.

<u>Year Four</u> Half Term 4

History - Christianity in 3 Empires.

We will look at how Christianity was embraced by the Roman, Byzantine and Aksumite empires. We will see how they were shaped by their beliefs and the struggles the populations had to overcome to successfully become fully Christian.

Music - Violin
